



Tennis Behavior

- Racket throwing, excessive noise or profanity are strictly forbidden and will not be permitted at any time.
- No physical &/or verbal confrontation with other players on the court/s.
- As a first offense of inappropriate player behavior on the tennis courts the player will receive a letter of warning. Second offense will be a sanction of the offending player's privileges for 2 weeks. Third offense a revocation of the offending player's tennis membership. Please see posted inappropriate player behavior.
- Also, refer to MHOA and RCC Rules, Regulations and General Information dated January 16, 2012, Section "Discipline," #1 & #2.

Proper Tennis Etiquette

- Smoking is prohibited in and around the tennis facility
- No games other than tennis are to be played on the courts
- Glass containers are prohibited on the tennis courts
- Cell phones should remain in the off position or on vibrate while on the courts
- Trash and recycling are to be placed in the provided containers
- Bicycles, scooters, skateboards, etc., are not allowed on the courts
- Please do not cut across a groomed court, the court may be ready for a match
- Maintenance of the courts should only be done by staff

Proper Tennis Attire

- Proper tennis attire is required. Proper tennis attire is that which is designed especially for tennis. Gentlemen must wear shirts with sleeves: t-shirts are not permitted. Warm-ups and sweat-shirts are allowed in cooler weather.
- Proper footwear is required. Basketball sneakers, running shoes, hiking boots/shoes, sandals, flip-flops, crocs, are prohibited. Tennis sneakers with a herringbone pattern are the only shoes that will not damage the surface, which is only ½ inch thick.

Court Reservations

- Reservations for a court may be made no more than 1 week in advance
- Courts, for singles and doubles play, are reserved in 1½ hour increments. Please make every effort to book courts in allotted time frame in order to make maximum use of court time, especially in season.
- At the end of playing period, players must promptly relinquish their court to the next players. Once a member is off the court, the member may sign up for the next available court time.
- All players, members, family and guests, are required to register in the Pro Shop before play. The staff will advise as to court assignments upon registration and as to which court/s may be closed or under repair.
- If players fail to appear within ten minutes of the reserved time, the court reservation will be forfeited.
- Guest fees in effect during season October-April.

TO PLAY OR NOT TO PLAY

- If the net is down, do not put the net back up and do not play on the court.
- Play or No Play how to tell. After a rain, if you rub off a small area of the top surface of the court and you see water coming to the surface, the courts are NOT playable.
